### THE SWITCH MASTER

Designer Gary Lee has lived in a Gold Coast high-rise overlooking the lake and the Mag Mile for 15 years, and to keep the modern space fresh, he switches up the look of his living room often. "The way a gallery might change out its art," he explains. Lee prefers living rooms that are actually made for living—never too formal—and he lays out his furniture to keep it fun. "The horizontal configurations stretch the space, and the openness invites an easygoing aura when entertaining."
